About Indian Paper Industry

The Paper Industry plays a very vital role in the industrial growth of the country and also provides a necessary medium to propel our knowledge based economy forward in the new millennium.

Indian Paper Industry has been acknowledged as a 'Sun Rise' industry by every agency in India. In India there are **759 pulp and paper mills** with an installed capacity of around **13.50 million tones** producing around **11.38 million tones**. As per industry guesstimates, over all paper consumption has now touched **13.10 million tons**. India is the fastest growing market for paper globally and it presents an exciting scenario; paper consumption is poised for a big leap forward in sync with the economic growth and is estimated to touch **13.95 million tons by 2015-16**. The estimated turnover of the industry is INR 500,000 million.

The consumption of Paper and board in India is expected to grow over **20 million tonnes by 2020** from the present installed capacity of around **13.5 million tonnes**.

The industry has a vision to install additional paper production capacity to reduce the dependence of the country on exports from other countries.

Paper Industry in South India

In these South Indian States there are around **130 Paper Mills** having an installed production capacity of duplex boards of **70,000 tonnes per month**, writing paper at **77,500 tonnes** and Kraft at **200,000 tonnes per month**.

India is the fastest growing market for paper globally and it presents an exciting scenario and we are seeing a growth of around 6-7%. Paper consumption is poised for a big leap forward in sync with the economic growth. It is now a vast industry comprising more than 750 pulp and paper mills, providing employment to more than 0.5 million people directly and 1.5 million people indirectly. The Indian Paper Industry accounts for about 3% of the world's production of paper, meeting not only the domestic demand but also making it one of the leading exporters.

The domestic market/consumption of paper is over 16 million tonnes per annum (TPA), with over 2 million TPA being imported. By 2024-25, under the baseline scenario, domestic consumption is projected to rise to 23.50 million TPA (in the optimistic scenario, consumption is expected to rise to 36.90 million TPA by 2024-25).

Due to growth in literacy, change in lifestyle and increasing consciousness for personal hygiene, per capita consumption of paper and tissue in India is increasing day by day and expected to increase by 1 kg that will increase Paper Production by 1 million tons. Though India's per capita consumption is quite low compared to global peers, things are looking up and demand is set to rise to an estimated 20 mt by 2020. Current demand for wood by Paper industry is about 11 million TPA, against domestic availability of 9 million TPA, and is projected to rise to 15 million TPA by 2024-25.

The growth in GDP of India has led to the increase in manufacturing activities, increasing the demand for paper products especially the paper boards for carrying out wide range of activities ranging from packaging to storage, transportation and lot more.

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With burgeoning demand for paper products and an increasingly severe shortage of raw materials at mills, now industry has again asked for a comprehensive industrial plantation policy.

Currently, most paper mills store raw material in the form of trees and plants from plantations owned by farmers. Since regulations don't allow industry ownership.

On Wednesday, minister of state for commerce and industry C R Choudhary suggested the industry involving at least of recycling waste categories. Choudhary was speaking at Paperex 2017, the world's largest exhibition for paper, paper products and related equipment, recycling at India in 40-50 per cent. It is over 65 per cent in Japan, senior industry sources said.

"Today, the model of large plantations to farm factory, we have entered with farmers across Odisha, Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat and Maharashtra but with demand community rising, availability of wood is the single biggest problem," Harsh Pati Singhania, vice-chairman and managing director of IPMA, told Business Standard. He said pressure on the industry was set to rise, with the average compounded annual growth rate pegged at 18 to 20 per cent. The corresponding figure for specific paper products such as boards is between 15 and 16 per cent.

Last year, the environment ministry had proposed allowing private industry to use land designated as degraded suitable for plantation. However, the sensitive nature of allowing private firms to take control of degraded forest, the proposal lost steam.

The country's forest cover, according to the 2015 Forest Status Report, increased by 0.575 million hectares in comparison with the 2013 report. Forest and tree cover is 76.12 per cent or 24.2 per cent of geographical area, much above the 30 per cent estimate at the start of this century. This is, however, way below the policy target of 33 per cent.

"We Paperex again submitted a proposal to the environment ministry but have heard nothing so far. I clarify that we do not seek ownership of the land but are willing to partner with forest development authorities and buy back the products at agreed rates," Saranath Bangar, president of the Indian Paper Manufacturers Association, told Business Standard.

As at, not to let growing levels of forest degradation bring down stock, chances of creating an additional 1.5 to 2 billion tonnes of carbon sink through plantation by 2030, the ministry is again studying the proposal, a senior official said. Per capita consumption of paper in the country is 54 kg a year, compared to 350 kg in America.

The global average is 54 kg. Under pressure to source inputs, manufacturers have increasingly resorted to importing pulp and other materials from abroad, mainly Asia.

With escalation in cost on the production side, the plan by Indian companies to enter the export market has been pushed back, a senior official from Delhi-based Paper and Board told Business Standard. Exports are a small share of Indian firm's business operations.
